

**MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 12.07.2022
AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DC'S
OFFICE, LAKHIMPUR.**

The meeting was presided over by Sri Sumit Sattawan, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Lakhimpur. At the very onset, DC Lakhimpur welcomed all the members present and the meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the minutes of the last DDC meeting held on 18.06.2022. The General Instruction and the department wise discussions are as follows:-

General Instructions

1. The chair intimated the house about the scheme Chief Minister's Institutional Plantation Programme (CMIPP). In this regard he asked all the HoDs to select a venue & date for plantation and appoint a nodal officer.
2. The DC directed that 100% disposal of the pension process of the retired employees must be done through the Kritagyata Portal & that the process may be initiated 6 months before the date of retirement.
