

**MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 11.10.2021 AT 12.30 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DC'S OFFICE, LAKHIMPUR.**

Members Presents: - As per ANNEXURE-I.

The meeting was presided over by Sri Sumit Sattawan, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Lakhimpur. At the very onset, DC Lakhimpur welcomed all the members present and the meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the minutes of the last DDC meeting held on 17.01.2021. The General Instruction and the department wise discussions are as follows:-

**General Instruction:**

1. The DC informed that a proposal for integrated DC Office will be prepare by concerned dept. for submission to govt. at the earliest.
2. The DC informed the house that the cross-departmental verification of various schemes will be implemented soon.
3. The DC urged all the dept. to install LED bulbs with utmost priority and submit a report regarding LED convergence in the next DDC meeting.
4. The DC insisted on gradual implementation of e-office and requested all the dept. to facilitate necessary training to their staff.
5. The DC asked all the dept. to analyse the causes of public footfall in various depts.
