

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF DISTRICT LEVEL IMPLEMENTATION, MONITORING AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE, LAKHIMPUR & DISTRICT LEVEL SPECIAL TASK FORCE, LAKHIMPUR ON NGT MATTERS HELD ON 03-08-2020 AT 11:00 AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF O/O THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, LAKHIMPUR**

The meeting was chaired Dr. Jeevan B., IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Lakhimpur cum Chairman, District Level Implementation, Monitoring and Advisory Committee, Lakhimpur & District Level Special Task Force, Lakhimpur. At the very outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of both the committees present in the meeting and initiated the discussion.

The absence of the Divisional Forest Officer (T), Lakhimpur cum Member Secretary & Convenor of the District Level Implementation, Monitoring and Advisory Committee is viewed very seriously by the Chairman. The absence of the officials/representative from Pollution Control Board of Assam, RO, Tezpur, Executive Officers of Dhakuakhana, Bihpuria and Narayanpur Municipal Board as well as Block Development Officers of Dhakuakhana & Ghilamara Development Block has also been taken very seriously as they play vital role in implementation of various orders passed by the Hon'ble NGT. Chairman warned all concerned members of the committee to remain present in all succeeding meetings without fail.


After threadbare discussion on various issues in the matter of strict implementation of Hon'ble NGT orders the following points are noted:

1. All concerned members are directed to strictly go through the NGT orders in the matter of implementation of the same.
2. All members to submit their Action Taken Reports to the Chairman before 3(three) days of succeeding meetings.
3. All the stakeholders have been directed to submit quarterly report regularly on District Environment & Action Plan (*uploaded in the official website of the District : lakhimpur.nic.in*)
4. All concerned officers are requested to submit their Action Taken Report in the matter of protection and capacity enhancement of water bodies in compliance of Hon'ble NGT order dtd. 01-06-2020 in O.A. No. 325/2020 **by 17-08-2020 positively without fail.** (*Communicated to all concerned vide DC's letter No. LDC.80/NGT/ Reports/ 2019/71 dtd. 22-06-2020 / copy enclosed*)
5. CEO, Zilla Parishad, Lakhimpur as well as representative from Orchid India (NGO) informed the meeting that the Dikrong River is highly polluted in between Harmutty and Banderdewa area due to industrial wastage discharged from AIDC Industrial area and nearby stone crushers. The meeting requested CEO, Zilla Parishad, Lakhimpur and BDO, Karunabri to submit a factual report on the matter along with Action Plan for cleaning of the river.
6. GM, DICC is requested to submit a report on management of waste materials discharged from the Banderdewa Industrial Complex within 7 (seven) days.
7. Meeting requested CEO, Zilla Parishad, Lakhimpur to conduct IEC activities along with placing of litter bins at Seajuli GP which is recently selected as Model G.P. of the district as per Hon'ble NGT order.

8. All ULB authorities have been requested to achieve 100% target in door to door garbage collection with segregation.
9. The Executive Officer, North Municipal Board informed that cabins for storage of plastic will be installed at various location of North Lakhimpur town within a short span of time.
10. In the matter of Biomedical Waste Management Health Authority, Lakhimpur is directed to issue notice to all private hospitals to install incinerator (in individual or common) as per the norms of Clinical Establishment Act.
11. Executive Engineer, PWD (B), North Lakhimpur is requested to submit a progress report on installation of incinerator at New Medical College premises and to take immediate steps for installation of the same at the earliest.
12. All BDOs are requested to complete the survey of all existing water bodies and submit survey report along with Action Plan for next 3(three) years for protection and capacity enhancement of the water bodies under their jurisdiction as per Hon'bel NGT Order dtd. 01-06-2020 in OA No. 325/2020 to the Chairman on before 17-08-2020. BDOs may also opt for conduct of Arial Survey by engaging such service providers.
13. The Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Lakhimpur is requested to issue necessary instruction to all the Circle Officers for demarcation of wetlands and to take strict action for eviction of encroachment over the wet lands under their respective jurisdiction. Action Taken Report in this regard to be submitted by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Lakhimpur within 1(one) month.
14. The District Level Special Task Force emphasised on creating awareness among school authorities and students for setting up of compost pits in the schools premises to handle with the food wastages of MDM. DEEO, Lakhimpur and Inspector of Schools, LDC, Lakhimpur will take necessary steps in this regard.
15. Students may be motivated for collection of plastic wastages. DEEO, Lakhimpur & IS, LDC, Lakhimpur is requested to select few schools within North Lakhimpur Town as Model schools. The Executive Officer, North Lakhimpur Municipal Board informed the meeting that he is interested to provide incentive to the students taking active participation on collection of plastic wastages out of his IEC Fund.
16. The District Agriculture Officer is requested take necessary steps to discourage burning of hay by the farmers. Farmers may be motivated for storage of hays as cattle feed.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
